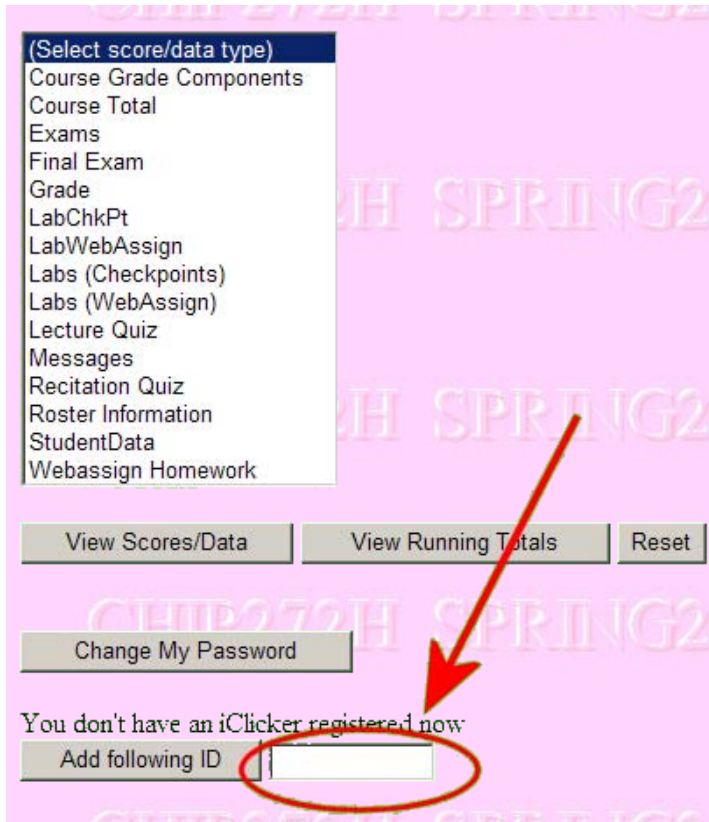
1. Open the course WEB site using the drop-down list box on the Physics Department web site (or your bookmarks): <http://www.physics.purdue.edu/>

2.. Login into your CHIP grade book from the course web site
