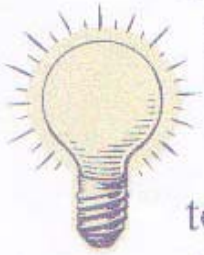


## Warren Central Science Seminar From Purdue
