1. A formal letter of nomination (1-2 pages from the principal/supervisor),
2. A current resume or curriculum vitae (1-2 pages from the physics teacher),
3. Up to five (1-2 page) letters supporting the nomination (from former students, current students, parents, colleagues, etc.).
